Report on U.S. History Standards Erroneously Attributed to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board

November 9, 2011 – Austin, Texas – A recent report released by Keith Erekson, a faculty member at The University of Texas El Paso and member of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB) Social Studies Faculty Collaborative titled <u>Bridging the Gap Between K-12 and College Readiness Standards in Texas: Recommendations for U.S. History has been erroneously attributed to the THECB in an article published by the Dallas Morning News on November 7th.</u>

This report was not requested, reviewed or approved by the THECB or its staff. The faculty collaborative is funded by the THECB, however the agency does not have ownership for the work product derived from the collaborative. Products developed by the collaborative do not reflect opinions, analysis, or conclusions of the agency or its Board.
