- Reports, communications, or notes generated by the District Diversity Council detailing any processes discussed or established for tracking microaggressions from August 1, 2018 to August 2, 2020.
- Surveys given to students about diversity, discrimination, religion, sexual orientation, or gender identity from August 1, 2018 to August 2, 2020.


If you do not maintain any relevant records, please let me know who does and include the proper custodian's name and address.
