Re: TPIA 2022-469 *Public Information Request dated March 9, 2022; Cost Estimate*

Dear Ms. Castle,

On March 9, 2022, you submitted a request for information. You are requesting:

- 1) *Number of students in RRISD who are currently allowed to use the restroom, locker room, shower facilities, or housing that is different than the student's sex designated on their birth certificate.*
- 2) *Number of students at RRHS who are currently allowed to use the restroom, locker room, shower facilities, or housing that is different than the student's sex designated on their birth certificate.*
- 3) *The initial date RRHS opened to students the option to choose sex designated restrooms, locker rooms, shower facilities, or housing that is different than the student's sex designated on their birth certificate.*
- 4) *Any communications between staff and leadership at RRHS about allowing students to enter sex designated restrooms, locker rooms, and changing rooms, that are different than the student's sex designated on their birth certificate.*
- 5) *Any emails from the U.S. Department of Education or any other federal government employee or agency on policies or guidance regarding students using restrooms, locker rooms, and changing rooms based on their gender identity or gender expression.*
- 6) *Any emails from the Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) about students using restrooms, locker rooms, shower facilities, and housing.*

CLARIFICATION:

Timeframe: *August 1, 2021- March 9, 2022 (as stated in the letter)*

Keywords: *“restroom”, “locker room”, “shower facility” “housing” “changing rooms” “bathrooms” “sex designated on birth certificate” “gender identity” “gender expression” (as stated in the letter)*

Email addresses: *those of “Round Rock High School staff and leadership”, “U.S. Department of Education”, “federal government employee” “federal agency” “Texas Association of School Boards” (TASB) (as stated in letter)*

Pursuant to Texas Government Code § 552.261, et. al, Round Rock ISD may charge a requestor "an amount that reasonably includes all costs related to reproducing the public information, including costs of materials, labor, and overhead." TEX GOV'T CODE § 552.261(a). Because Round Rock ISD has determined that complying with your request for this information may result in the imposition of a charge that exceeds \$40.00, RRISD is providing

you with this cost estimate as required by Texas Government Code § 552.2615.

The above estimate is for paper copies. Electronic copies can be obtained for the labor and overhead charges only, plus any other costs, additional labor and overhead charges to convert the paper copies into an electronic format.

Payment requirement and other options:

Should an estimate exceed \$100.00, a Deposit in the amount of 50% of the estimate must be paid before the work will begin. By inspecting the materials rather than having the District produce the materials would still require the labor charges, but would save you, as the requestor, some fees for copies. Additionally, there may be fee savings for the labor, as estimated.

Please be aware that your request will be considered automatically withdrawn if you do not respond in writing to this itemized statement within ten (10) business days informing the District that: (1) you accept the estimated charges; (2) that you are modifying your request; or (3) that you have sent a complaint to the Attorney General.
